




#### **Town Profile:**

# **Rowley Regis**

Rowley Regis is one of six towns in Sandwell. It is situated in the southwest of Sandwell and contains the wards of Blackheath, Cradley Heath and Old Hill, Rowley and Tividale. Rowley Regis borders Dudley to the South and West.







The population of Rowley Regis town grew by 7% between 2011 and 2021. Cradley Heath and Old Hill ward had the largest percentage change of all the wards within Oldbury town, growing by 10.3%. Looking at broad age groups, the 20-64 group in Rowley Regis town had the largest increase, of 4.1% over the ten-year period.

The number of full-time employees in Rowley Regis town is slightly higher than Sandwell. All the wards have unemployment at 4.2% except Rowley at 3.4%. These figures are slightly lower than Sandwell (4.5%). Blackheath also has the highest percentage of retired residents, with 22.5% compared to 17.4% across Sandwell.


10% of residents in Rowley Regis town provide unpaid care, with 3.4% providing 50 hours a week or more. This is slightly higher than Sandwell (3.2%).



The percentage of residents who are disabled under the Equalities Act is in line with Sandwell, at 20%. The percentage of residents who are long-term sick or disabled is slightly higher than Sandwell at 25.7%.

The percentage of residents with no qualifications is lower in Rowley Regis town (27%) than in Sandwell (29%). Tividale and Cradley Heath have the highest percentage of residents with a Level 4 qualification or above (21%) which is slightly lower than Sandwell (23%).


3.1% of households in Rowley Regis town have no resident who speaks English as a main language, compared to 9% in Sandwell. This is particularly low in Rowley (2%) and higher in Tividale ward (5%).

In England, the lower layer super output areas (LSOA\*) are ranked into 10 deciles for Deprivation.

• 58% of the LSOAs in Rowley Regis town are in the top 20% most deprived LSOAs in England (Sandwell, 60%)

Rowley Regis's average Income Deprivation Affecting Children Index (IDACI) and Income Deprivation Affecting Older People Index (IDAOPI) Scores are in the 30 and 35% most deprived deciles areas in England respectively.


On average Rowley Regis town is less deprived than Sandwell but more deprived than England and its deprivation score would put it in the 31% most deprived areas in England.






#### Income Deprivation, 2019



#### Income Deprivation Affecting Children Index, 2019








#### Income Deprivation Affecting Older People Index, 2019



The majority of housing in Rowley Regis town is owner-occupied (58%). Apart from Cradley Heath & Old Hill, social renting is lower than Sandwell (29% and 27% respectively). Private renting is also lower than Sandwell at 19%.

Overcrowding is lower in Rowley (5%) than in Sandwell (8%), however it is higher in Cradley Heath and Old Hill ward (7%).

Household composition within Rowley Regis town is mostly in line with Sandwell.



Female life expectancy at birth in Cradley Heath and Old Hill and Tividale was statistically significantly lower than England's. However, Rowley exceeded England's figure.


Male life expectancy at birth in all the wards was lower than the England figure. All three wards apart from Rowley were also statistically significantly lower than England's.

The prevalence of overweight (including obesity) at Year 6 is higher in Rowley Regis town (44%) than England (36%). The rate of emergency admissions for injuries in children under 5 years old is higher in Rowley Regis town (127.1) than England (119.3), however is still lower than Sandwell (133.4). Tividale ward is particularly high with a rate of 165.0.

Deliveries to teenage mothers were higher in Rowley Regis town (1.38%) than Sandwell (1.07%). Low birth weight is in line with Sandwell (9%), however Tividale was much higher than the other wards, with 10%.

Incidence of lung cancer is lower in Rowley Regis than England, however Sandwell is higher. Breast cancer is much lower, however is higher in Rowley Regis town than Sandwell and England. Breast cancer in Rowley ward is statistically significantly higher than England.


Emergency hospital admissions for heart attack are slightly lower in Rowley Regis town (SAR 112.8) than Sandwell (113.9). This is significantly higher in Rowley ward (129). Emergency admissions for COPD are lower at town level (134.2) compared to Sandwell (157.3).

Looking at deaths from circulatory diseases in the under 75's, Sandwell has a significantly higher standardised mortality ratio than Rowley Regis town (148.5 and 124.7 respectively). Rowley is the ward with the lowest SMR, at 111.3.






#### General Health of Rowley Regis residents by Age, 2021

The crime rate per 1,000 residents is lower in Rowley Regis town (113.4) than in Sandwell (121.7). Blackheath ward has a particularly high crime rate, with 141.5.


Violence and sexual offences were the most prevalent type of crime across all areas. Vehicle crime was highest in Rowley (11%) compared to 10% in Sandwell. Burglary was highest in Cradley Heath & Old Hill (7%), when compared to Rowley Regis town (6%) and Sandwell (5%).







## 8. Child Development - Education

The percentage of children achieving a good level of development at the end of Reception is slightly lower in Rowley Regis town (58.0%) than Sandwell (59.1%). Both are lower than the national figure of 65.2%.

The average Attainment 8 score in Rowley Regis town is 46.0, which is in line with the national figure (48.8%). Sandwell is slightly lower with 45.7%.

The average Progress 8 score for Rowley Regis is higher than both England and Sandwell, at 0.08.
